### Question

Is it allowed to use the diopter sight from the Bristlen a Morges (percussion target rifle) on the Swiss Match (flintlock target rifle)? In this case the pendulum sight on the barrel wil be removed.

#### Remarks

It is allowed to use a diopter sight on a flintlock rifle used in the disciplines Pennsylvania and/or Maximilian. The diopter however has to be of a contemporry design. Since the Bristlen diopter is clearly from the percussion era it is not allowed on a flintlock rifle. The flintlock diopters were of a simpler design similar to the diopters on the Pedersoli Yaeger or Mortimer.
