*Is the use of a coating on muzzleloading bullets permitted?*

**Remarks**

*The SAC proposes to add a new rule :* *4.8.c.)*  
*iiii* *BULLETS :*  
 - *Bullets for all disciplines must be made of lead or a lead alloy only and can be bare, greased or paper patched.*  
 - *A lead alloy may only consist of lead, tin and/or antimony and trace elements with a minimum of 80% lead.*  
 - *Gas checks and/or non-period coatings are forbidden.*  
 - *No plastic wads are permitted. Wads may be made from natural organic materials.* -  
*Only paper, cloth or leather is allowed for patching projectiles.*
