### Question

Are helical coil springs (compression, tension or torsion) forbidden in weapons used in MLAIC disciplines?

#### **Remarks**

Since there were no helical coil springs used in original muzzleloading arms they are not allowed in any MLAIC discipline.

Flat spiral coil springs however are used in Japanese matchlocks and are allowed in the disciplines Hizadai-O, Tanegashima-O and Tanzutsu.








Pictures 1 and 2 show a mechanism with coil spring.

Picture 3 shows a mechanism with correct spring. This can be identified from the outside by the screw (green circle).
